Classes:

Slalom

K1, K1W, C1, C1W, C2

Cadets (age 14 & under), Juniors (age 15-18), Seniors (age 19 and above).

Night Slalom

Men's, Women's

NOTE: It takes 3 boats to make a class.

Race Format:

Day 1: Qualifier: Two individual runs - best run counts. The number of boats advancing to the semis will be posted prior to the beginning of 1st runs, and will be announced at the athlete's meeting. They will be dependent on the size of the class. (Estimated semifinal cutoffs are 20 for K1, 10 for K1W, etc).

Day 2: First Run – 1st run for those boats that were eliminated after the Day 1 Qualifier (these boats are not reseeded). Immediately after, Semifinalists start in reverse order from Heat results. Second Run – All eliminated athletes take their 2nd runs. Shortly after, Finals (top 10 or less), start in reverse order from Semifinal results.

Course:

Slalom races will be held on the Nantahala River at the Falls Course. Night Slalom will be held on the lower section of the Nantahala, beginning at the pedestrian bridge.

Entry Fees:

Slalom: \$55 per person for first class plus \$5 for each additional class. Night Slalom registration is included in the event cost.

USACK membership required. One-day USACK memberships available at registration. All competitors are required to have a US Forest Service pass. These will be checked during boat control inspection.

Meals:

Dinner and entertainment will be provided Saturday evening.

Registration:

Registration forms, waivers, and fees must arrive at the NRC office by Wednesday, September 28th. We regret that we cannot be responsible for mail that is not delivered by this date; please mail your forms early to ensure delivery. On-site registration with an additional \$15 late fee will be accepted Friday, September 30th, from 2-4pm. **There will be no race-day registration.**
